



Modules at a Glance: Pre-eclampsia & Eclampsia (PE&E)

An on-site training for healthcare providers working in clinical settings.

Pre-eclampsia & Eclampsia (HMS PE&E) is a module designed to address the second leading cause of maternal mortality globally, pre-eclampsia & eclampsia. This module helps teams of providers act quickly to diagnose and begin treatment of this dangerous complication. Training starts by building capacity of any provider who may encounter pregnant, laboring, and post-partum women in the antenatal clinic, the outpatient department, or the labor ward who need to be able to rapidly diagnose, treat, and refer women to higher levels of care. Learners move on to learn safe management and ongoing treatment.

KEY COMPETENCIES COVERED

- Correct assessment and classification of hypertensive disorders of pregnancy.
- Administration of loading and maintenance doses of magnesium sulfate (MgSO₄) and antihypertensive medications.
- Management of convulsions.

DURATION/INTENDED AUDIENCE

- Day 1: Designed for all team members who may care for pregnant, laboring, and post-partum women who need to diagnose rapidly at any level of the health system.
- Day 2: Designed specifically to build capacity of skilled birth attendants to provide high quality care for ongoing management of the pre-eclamptic or eclamptic woman.

SUGGESTED SIMULATORS

No anatomical simulator required; this module utilizes low-cost, locally sourced materials for simulated learning activities.
